



2024 Marina Recap

As we bid farewell to 2024 and step into a promising new year, it's a great time to reflect on the projects and milestones that were achieved over the past twelve months.

Projects Completed:

- Replaced the main electrical feed cables to E, F and G docks
- Added a self-service ice machine and Clear Token in the laundry room and restrooms.
- Resided the Harbormasters office
- Repainted the fuel tanks
- Completed many dock, cement and pile hoop repairs and/or replacements
- Completed the first phase of the dredge project and started the permitting phase

Milestones Achieved:

- Welcomed nearly 700 individual guest boats
- Sold approximately 130,000 gallons of fuel
- Hosted the Marina's 50th birthday celebration
- Received our 5th consecutive Boaters Choice award

Marina Parking Lot

The marina parking lot is not meant for vehicle storage. Any vehicle left for more than 72 hours will be charged the daily parking rate and may be towed at the owners expense.

As a reminder, our Policies, Procedures and General Operation Guide states:

X. Vehicle Parking General Rules

*All parking regulations are enforced 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

*Any vehicle parked on Oak Harbor Marina property must be used as a regular and necessary means of transportation and must be operational.

*Storage of vehicles, motor homes, and recreational vehicles is not permitted on Oak Harbor Marina property.

*All vehicles staying beyond 72-hours must registerwith the Marina office.

*Maintenance of vehicles is not allowed on Oak Harbor Marina property.

*All parking and traffic regulations as per Oak Harbor Municipal Code Chapter 10.12 apply to the marina parking lots.

Operational Seaworthiness –72 hour

Starting in the new year, marina staff will be going through each dock and marking which boats need to schedule a operational demonstration of their boat's seaworthiness. We will send out letters, emails and text messages to boat owners that need to complete this demonstration. Owners will have 14 days from the letter to schedule a demonstration. If no demonstration is completed, moorage agreement will be terminated and a daily moorage fee will be charged until boat is removed from marina. This is per signed agreement:

II. OPERATING CONDITION OF BOAT. *The Boat shall be kept in such operating condition that it is able to safely get under way from its berth upon reasonable notice by City (72 hours). The Owner shall comply with any request from the Harbormaster for an operational demonstration of the Boat's seaworthiness within 72 hours of such a request from Harbormaster.*

Slip Modifications and Addition's

Would you like to add extra cleats, haul huggers, bumper wheels, or other features to your slip? If so, please reach out to the marina to discuss the available options.

After speaking with the marina staff, you can order the parts you'd like to have installed. Please note that all new slip components must be installed by marina staff, and labor fees will be added to your account.

Once any additions are installed in your slip, they become the property of the marina and cannot be removed when you vacate the slip.

Tenants are not permitted to install or remove items from their slips.

Yearly Contracts

Most of our annual contracts will expire on January 31, 2025. The marina will be emailing yearly tenants to confirm whether they wish to renew their contract for another year.

As part of this renewal process, please ensure we have up-to-date insurance and registration on file. Without these documents, we will not be able to extend your annual contract, and you will need to remove your boat from the marina. If we do not hear from you about renewing your yearly contract, we will start to charge you the monthly rate on February 1st, 2025.
