REGISTRATION POLICY

Pre-registration is required for all programs, and full payment must be made at the time of registration to secure your spot. Class sizes are limited, and registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Programs may be canceled due to **low enrollment, inclement weather**, or other unforeseen circumstances. To help ensure your favorite programs run as planned, **please register early**.

*Please note: Program details are subject to change. New classes are added regularly, so check our **online registration portal** for the most current updates and offers.

PROGRAM REFUND POLICY

(Does Not Apply to Marina)

Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation reserves the right to cancel, reschedule, or combine activities, programs, or events as necessary. If a program is canceled by Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation, participants will receive a **full refund** or the option to **transfer funds** to another available program.

PARTICIPANT-INITIATED WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawal requests must be submitted in writing (email is acceptable) and are not considered final until confirmed in writing by Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation staff.

Refunds or account credits will be issued for withdrawal requests received at least seven (7) calendar days before the program start date, unless otherwise noted in the specific program description. Refunds requested by participants will be subject to the following conditions:

- A **\$10 administrative withdrawal fee** will be deducted per registrant, per program.
- Any **non-refundable expenses** already incurred by Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation (e.g., supplies, shirts, tickets, books, fees, etc.) will also be deducted.
- Participants may request an **account credit** for the full program fee (excluding incurred costs), in lieu of a refund.

No refunds or credits will be issued for:

- Withdrawal requests received **within seven (7) calendar days** of a program's start date.
- **No-shows, late arrivals, or partial participation** in a program.
- **Illness, injury, family emergencies, unexpected scheduling conflicts**, or other personal circumstances.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Refunds of **\$10 or less** will not be issued, unless due to cancellation by Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation.
- Refunds will be processed by check and may take **up to 30 days** to be issued and mailed.
- Refund policies are enforced **uniformly**, and **exceptions will not be made**, regardless of circumstance.
- This refund policy is subject to change and without notice.

FACILITY REFUND POLICY

(Does Not Apply to Marina)

Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any facility rental at its sole discretion. In the event that Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation cancels a rental, the renter will receive a full refund or may opt to transfer the payment to another available date.

RENTER-INITIATED CANCELLATIONS

All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing via email to parksandrec@oakharbor.org and are not considered final until confirmed in writing by Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation staff.

Refunds will be processed as follows:

- **REFUNDS**, minus a \$10 administrative fee will be processed for cancellations received at least seven (7) calendar days before the scheduled rental date.
- **NO REFUNDS** will be processed for cancellations received within seven (7) calendar days of the rental date.

Refunds will not be granted due to:

- Inclement weather, unless the facility is officially closed by Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation.

- Illness, injury, family emergencies, or any unforeseen personal circumstances.
- No-shows or partial use of the rented facility.

DATE CHANGE REQUESTS

Requests to reschedule a facility rental must also be submitted in writing to parksandrec@oakharbor.org and are subject to availability. Rescheduling requests made at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the original rental date may be transferred to another available date free of charge. If the request includes changing facilities, any difference in rental rates is due at time of transfer. Oak Harbor Parks & Recreation cannot guarantee the availability of preferred alternate dates.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- All refunds will be issued by check and may take up to 30 days for processing and delivery.
- Refund policies are enforced consistently and without exception.
- By reserving a facility, the renter agrees to the terms of this policy.
- This refund policy is subject to change and without notice.



IN PROGRESS & COMING SOON! FREEDOM PARK TRAILS & DISC GOLF

Freedom Park is a naturally wooded, 75-acre park located on the north side of Oak Harbor, within City limits. When fully developed, the park will feature an 18-hole championship-caliber disc golf course and a dedicated walking trail system, both much-needed amenities for the community.



During the planning and creation process, the Urban Forestry team has identified old-growth fir trees, native vegetation stands, and wildlife ranging from mule deer to a barred owl. These natural features, along with unique geological formations, will be highlighted throughout the trail system.

Because of the park's size and potential for expansion, the final number of trails has not yet been determined. Currently, the only named trail is Slippery Squirrel Trail—the runner-up in a naming contest held by Oak Harbor Elementary. We may continue with this fun and creative naming theme for future trails.

Freedom Park will offer residents a place to enjoy nature, providing a peaceful retreat within the city. It is anticipated that Freedom Park trails will be accessible to the public late spring 2026. Watch for more information to come!



YOUR DOG CALLED AND ASKED US TO TELL YOU ABOUT OUR OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

Located at the end of NE 21st Ct., the Technical Drive Off-Leash Dog Park includes two separate areas: a 1.04-acre small dog section and a 0.52-acre large dog section. A communal gated area at the end of the street allows visitors to safely leash or unleash their dogs.

Amenities include dog waste bag stations, a community information board, a frost-free water spigot, a small overhead shelter, and picnic benches located throughout both sections.

Recently, our parks team renovated the fence line between the small and large dog areas and railroad ties were installed beneath the fence line to stabilize the slope. Additionally, a new water meter was installed, restoring full functionality to the spigot.
