BUSINESS AND OCCUPATION TAX

PUBLIC COMMENT

- On May 21, 2024 a proposed ordinance was presented to City Council for B&O Tax implementation, which was not adopted.
- On December 18, 2024, Deputy City Administrator Goldman led two public B&O Tax Talks and presented the details of a potential local B&O Tax and answered questions from the community.
- During the discussion about the potential for the creation of a Port District at the January 21, 2025, Council Meeting, the implementation of a local B&O Tax was discussed.
- During the discussions at the February 25, 2025, and March 25, 2025 City Council Workshops regarding the implementation of a local B&O Tax, Council provided feedback to staff regarding the characteristics of an Oak Harbor B&O Tax.

Use of the funds for the following purposes:

- For the construction, repair, replacement, or rejuvenation of City Marina facilities and dredging and for the servicing of any debt issued by the City for said purposes.
- For the purpose of the construction of a new community recreation center and for the servicing of any debt issued by the City for said purpose.

Business effected

Gross annual receipts exemption threshold = \$5,000,000.

- Rate = 0.002.
- Effective date = July 1, 2025.
- Initial collection date = January 31, 2026; quarterly thereafter.

At the \$5,000,000 threshold it is estimated that about 26 businesses could be affected and at the \$2,500,000 threshold it is estimated that about 59 businesses could be affected.

August 6th Council Meeting will discuss and vote on the B&O tax.

City Council meetings are public forums where the Mayor and City Council discuss matters relevant to City. If you have comments regarding an issue in the City of Oak Harbor, you can express them during the public comment portion of City Council meetings. City Council workshops are informal settings at which public comment is not solicited unless 1) an action item has been noticed, or 2) is otherwise permitted by a majority of City Council.

The City's advisory boards also provide for a public comment period during meetings. All comments received will be distributed as appropriate; however, anonymous comments will not be placed into the meeting record.

Comments submitted using one of the three options will be placed into the record for the requested meeting when the agenda item is presented.
