




FMCSA Post Accident Testing Decision Tree



The company will conduct post-accident drug and/or alcohol testing in accordance with 49 CFR 382.303. As soon as practicable following an accident involving a commercial motor vehicle(*CMV) requiring a CDL, the company shall ensure that each surviving CMV driver is tested for alcohol and/or controlled substances in accordance with the triggering events for FMCSA as defined in 49 CFR 382.303. The company is responsible for ensuring the drivers may be required to have a DOT-mandated drug and/or alcohol test(s) after certain accidents.

Alcohol testing should occur within two (2) hours, but no later than eight (8) hours following the qualifying accident. **Drug testing** must occur within 32 hours of the accident. If testing is not administered within the stated time frames, the company shall prepare and keep on file a record stating why the test was not promptly administered.
