Location for delivery must be clear of overhead obstructions (wires and trees) and on solid level ground. The Solid Waste Division is not liable for damaged concrete, ruts, or damaged underground utilities, when placed in the location of your choosing. The Solid Waste Division will refuse delivery if the area chosen is deemed unsafe or inaccessible for servicing.

1. The primary uses for the temporary dumpster service shall be construction, demolition, renovation, remodeling, special clean up, and events. Permits may be required. Call 360-279-4510 or 360-279-4517 to verify.
2. Temporary dumpster service will not exceed three months. At the end of three months the container will be removed unless the container was removed earlier at the agreement holder's request.
3. The temporary dumpster service shall not substitute regular services. Temporary service will be in addition to regular service and service charges.
4. **Roofing material only allowed in the two-yard container at twice the charge of the pickup fee.**
5. When requesting pickup, lids must be closed and no obstructions within five feet of the container.
6. Infectious, toxic, and hazardous wastes shall not be placed in the container. This includes but is not limited to paint, fertilizer, motor oil, batteries, and acids. Such wastes must be disposed of in accordance with state and federal law. (initial) \_\_\_\_\_
7. Items that may damage the container or collection vehicle such as but not limited to, tires, large appliances, refrigeration units, scrap metal, bricks, asphalt, concrete, rocks, sod, dirt, gravel, lawn clippings, stumps, branches, and other yard debris, shall not be placed in the container. It is the duty of the agreement holder to dispose of these items separately in accordance with state and federal law. (initial) \_\_\_\_\_
8. Additional charges based upon actual labor, fuel, and vehicle expenses will apply for handling prohibited items and/or overloading the container in a manner which is likely to cause damage to the collection vehicle or container, creates litter condition, impede collection, or create chemical contamination.
9. Customer shall be liable for any loss or damage to rented container in excess of reasonable wear and tear.
